

Memo to Lincoln Families

October 1st, 2021

This memo is to inform you that individuals associated with Lincoln recently tested positive for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). The positive individuals are in isolation. Families of students who were identified as close contacts have been notified. Please monitor yourself/your student for signs and symptoms. Call a healthcare provider if symptoms start. Have your child stay home, if they are sick or are experiencing any symptoms related to COVID-19.

Just as a reminder, close contacts who are unvaccinated and not a pooled testing participant will be asked to quarantine from school for 10-full-days from last exposure to the positive individual. All unvaccinated close contacts will be asked to quarantine from non-school activities as well. A negative test result does not get an individual out of quarantine. A close contact that is participating in pooled testing can attend school and needs to quarantine outside of school. If you have not signed up for pooled testing and are interested in signing up, please contact the school. The next pooled testing is October 6, 2021.
